Light not only highlights the beautiful environments but also makes the new spaces functional in harmony with the needs that the project requires. The barrel, crossed and pavilion vaults of the different interiors, the size ratios between their surfaces and heights, the rhythmic sequences of the doors, windows and vaulted corridors reproduce the great and singular atmosphere of this eighteenth century building. The project provides a flexible system based on the concept of integration. A monolith characterized by a simple shape, perfectly integrated in a context devoid of gorgeous decorations as that of the Shelter of Pools, contains two different systems of indirect illumination whose devices are absolutely discrete and unobtrusive. All the interiors, except for the main staircase, are illuminated by discharge lamps with metallic iodides and by fluorescent lamps which assure a great expansion of the maintenance times.
