The courtyard, with its many colors and intense fragrances, is the main attraction of this noble palace of the 18th century, as well as the element around which the entire architecture is structured. A fountain having a diamond shape, which is anchored in a real local limestone (Breccia Irpina), dominates the scene and animates, with its water games and the sounds, the quiet atmosphere of this typically Mediterranean area. The effects of light, carefully orchestrated, contribute to the creation of a fantastic dimension of the garden. At night, a fiber-optic technology makes almost inexistent the presence of lighting fixtures, and adds a further note of wonder in this little corner of paradise illuminated by a light that is placed in continuous dialogue with the darkness of night and magic of the moon
